**Ground Transportation**

The Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA) is 10 miles from the downtown Austin hotels. The travel time is approximately 30 minutes. Their web site is full of general information.

Ground transportation between ABIA and the hotels is very convenient from the lower level baggage claim area, with shuttle service, taxis, or rental cars.

Taxi service to the downtown area is \$20 one-way per cab. Multiple passengers may be accommodated in each taxi. The Greater Austin Transportation Company web site has additional information.

The SuperShuttle ground transportation departs from the lower level curbside area approximately every 10 to 20 minutes, 7 days a week, 24 hours a day. Reservations from ABIA are not necessary, SuperShuttle service from the airport is available on a first come, first serve basis. The SuperShuttle desk is located inside the airport near the baggage claim area. For general information and a current Austin weather report go to their web site. The one-way shuttle service cost is \$10.75 and round-trip is \$19.50 to all downtown hotels. You may purchase a ticket from the driver; major credit cards are accepted onboard. <http://www.supershuttle.com/>

Rental cars are available on-site at ABIA, inside the airport near the baggage claim area. Parking is available at both hotels.
