From Chicago or Chicago O'Hare airport to Madison

By air

40 min/\$300

Operated by American Airlines and United Express.

Expensive as a separate airfare, much less so as part of a multi-city trip.

By bus

3.5 hours/\$30 bus-ride.

The company with most connections per day (8) is:

Take the bus in Chicago at the Amtrak Station (Jackson & Canal)

or in Chicago O'Hare either at Terminal 5 (International), lower level, door 5E or at the Bus/Shuttle Center, door 4.

Hop off at the last stop: Madison Memorial Union.

The Double Tree Hotel (525 W. Johnson St.) is located at a 0.5 mi walk from the Memorial Union:

Head east on Langdon St. for 0.1mi.

Turn right at N Lake St.

After 0.3mi, turn left at W Johnson St.

or you can call the hotel at 608-251-5511 and ask for the complementary shuttle to pick you up.

By car

150 miles/3 hours drive, with normal traffic.

Take the interstate **I-90 W**. Have cash ready, as it is a partial **toll road**.

Exit 142A.

Follow Highway 12/18W to Park St. exit (exit 261B) (approx. 6 mi.)

Turn right and follow Park St. North to W Johnson St. (approx. 2.5 mi.).

Turn right on W Johnson St. The Double Tree Hotel is located 4 blocks ahead, on right side of road. Parking in the hotel is complementary.

From MSN airport to Double Tree Hotel

6 miles/15min/\$0-15

As soon as you land, and as soon as allowed to do so, call the Double Tree Hotel at 608-251-5511 to request a complementary shuttle, indicating how many people are in your party.

Alternatively, taxi cabs station on the right end of the airport, as you exit.

Note on the Conference Center


The workshop will be held in the **Engineering Centers Building (1550 Engineering Dr.)** and **NOT**, as initially announced, at the **Pyle Center.**

From Hotel to Conference Center

1 mile/20min walking, 5-10 min driving

Walking: just head west (left, as you exit from the hotel) on W Johnson St, which eventually becomes Engineering Dr. (see map below).

Due to road-works, you may need to make a small deviation on Campus Dr. and N Randall St.



Complementary Shuttle: ask the hotel.

Public transportation: walk to University Ave. Take any bus that goes west and stops at University & Randall, such as no. 1, 2, 9, 12, 14, 15, 56, 57, 70, 71, 72, 74. Ask driver. Hop off at University & Randall. For details: http://www.cityofmadison.com/metro/.
